
1. Remove the legs and hooks from the seat frame.



2. Screw the legs into the seat module frame.




3. Remove the legs from the zipper pocket







4. Screw the legs into the frame.





5. Align the wedge brackets to connect the armrest/backrest module to the seat module and slide all the way down.



6. To build out your sofa, install the hooks on the module and push all the way down.





Start with the corner or chaise module if it is included with your sofa

7. Align the front and back of the seats then lift the next module onto the hooks to connect them together.

Repeat until all modules are connected.




You will have 2-4 left over hooks


8. First drape the cover over the seat frame. Align the front left and right corners. Secure the front edge velcro all the way across




9. Flip the module over onto its legs. Push the fabric toward the back.




10. Attach velcro from centre outward then secure the velcro on each side of the seat module. Ensure the corner seams align with the corner of the frame.




11. To cover the backrest, match the labels on the frame and cover, and pull the cover over the frame.



12. Align the seams on the end faces of the cover with the lining




13. Flip the frame over and secure the velcro starting with the bottom inside corners. Ensure the seam is lined up with the corner

Secure the velcro under the back cushion lastly



Product Information and Care

LINING FABRIC

Regular Care (Weekly)

- Vacuum regularly using low suction.
- Protect from direct sunlight.

Spot Cleaning

- Remove any spills immediately by gently blotting any liquid with a clean cloth.
- Scoop up any solids before blotting the remaining liquid.
- Use a mild detergent to gently remove any loose soilage.
- Do not scrub with a stiff brush.
- Use a clean cloth to blot out any excess liquid.
- Avoid over wetting as this may result in a water mark.
- Allow the fabric to air dry in a well ventilated area away from direct sunlight.

NOTE: PRETEST THE CLEANING METHOD ON A HIDDEN AREA OF THE SOFA. IF CHANGE IN COLOUR, OR TRANSFER DO NOT CONTINUE.


PILLING

Pilling can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear and should not be considered a fault. Fibre pills can be removed with a battery operated pilling tool, available from most haberdashery stores.

REMOVABLE COVERS

For correct care of the removable covers refer to the care label inside covers for additional cleaning instructions.
